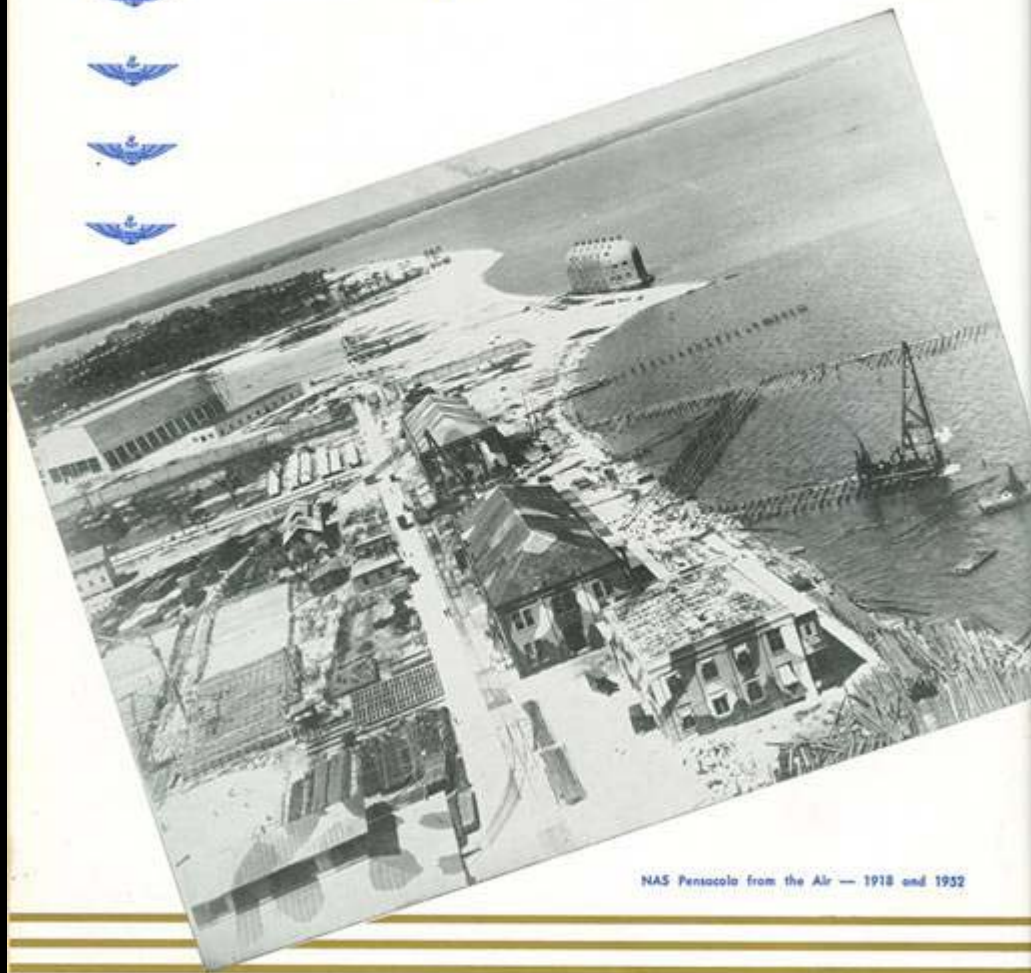

# NSACOLA

On Florida's Gulf Coast, just south of the Alabama line, lies the strategically situated and large harbor of Pensacola. It is here that "The Cradle of Naval Aviation", the country's first naval aviation station, was established. Comprising 4,218 acres, the site now occupied by the Naval Air Station has a colorful historical background dating back to the early 16th century.

When, in 1559, Don Tristan de Luna settled here with 2,000 followers, Pensacola, itself, became the site of the first settlement made in what is now the United States. Although this was the first settlement, it was not continuous for a hurricane completely destroyed the early settlement and the settlers abandoned the project. It was not re-established until several years after the settlement of St. Augustine.

In 1825 the Secretary of the Navy appointed a special Board of Commissioners consisting of three Navy Captains, William Bainbridge, L. Warrington and James Biddle, to make an investigation and select a site for the establishment of a navy yard. Their report, recommended the present site of the Naval Air Station as a Naval Station. This station had been authorized by Congress the previous year.

By 1910 Congress had let appropriations for the Navy decrease to such an extent that the Navy had to make drastic retrenchments. One of these was the closing of the Pensacola Navy Yard and Station.

Also, in this year 1910, the first naval officers were ordered to learn to fly under the instruction of the Wright Brothers and Mr. Glenn Curtiss,

and by 1913, naval aviation was in its initial stages of development. The few airplanes the Navy owned and the pitifully few personnel engaged in aviation had no base, so a Board was appointed to examine possible sites. This Board inspected, among other places, the abandoned navy yard at Pensacola and unanimously chose it as the finest possible site for a naval air station. Their wisdom has been proved through the years and today, it is one of the finest and largest air stations in the world.

During World War I, 999 pilots were trained here. During the gradual development of naval aviation, Pensacola became more and more important and during World War II a total of over 28,000 received their training here.

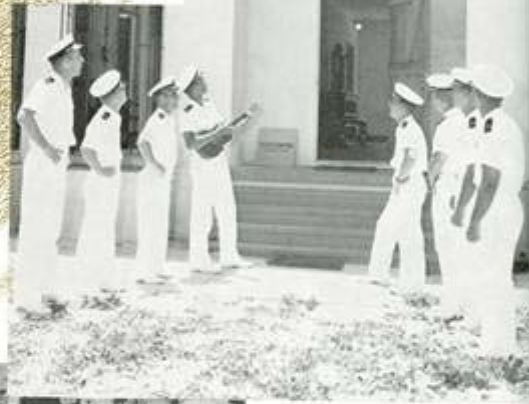

## FITZHUGH LEE

VICE ADMIRAL, U. S. NAVY  
CHIEF, NAVAL AIR TRAINING

Vice Admiral Fitzhugh Lee began his tour of duty as Chief of Naval Air Training, October 18, 1961, succeeding Vice Admiral Robert Goldthwaite.

A 1926 graduate of the U. S. Naval Academy, Admiral Lee was designated a Naval Aviator in 1929 after a tour of instruction at the Pensacola Naval Air Station. He returned to Pensacola again in 1936 as flight instructor and served in that capacity until 1938.

The majority of his WW II service was in the Pacific Theatre where he served with various elements of the Air Navy. VADM Lee was instrumental in streamlining news channels for meeting expanding needs for press copy, radio and pictorial coverage of activities in the Pacific Ocean Area. He was awarded the Navy Cross and Gold Star, Navy Unit Commendation, Legion of Merit and Commendation Ribbon for service during WW II.





## M. H. TUTTLE

REAR ADMIRAL, U. S. NAVY  
CHIEF OF NAVAL AIR BASIC TRAINING

Rear Admiral Magruder Hill Tuttle became Chief of Naval Air Basic Training on September 1, 1961. A 1932 graduate of the U. S. Naval Academy, he served at sea until 1934 when he came to Pensacola for flight training. He was designated a Naval Aviator in 1936 after serving as assistant football coach at the Naval Academy during the fall and winter of 1935-36.

He was Ordnance, Gunnery and Assistant Operations Officer at NAS Pearl Harbor when the Japanese attacked but was transferred to the Atlantic Fleet in 1942. In 1949 he reported as Executive Officer of the Pensacola School of Pre-Flight. In 1950 he became Commanding Officer of NAAS Carry Field, Pensacola where he remained until August 1951. He returned to Pensacola in 1954 as Chief of Staff and Aide to the Chief of Naval Air Basic Training. Prior to returning to Pensacola as Chief of NABT in September, RADM Tuttle commanded the USS PHILIPPINE SEA and was Commander Carrier Division 20.

## *Familiar to all flight students*

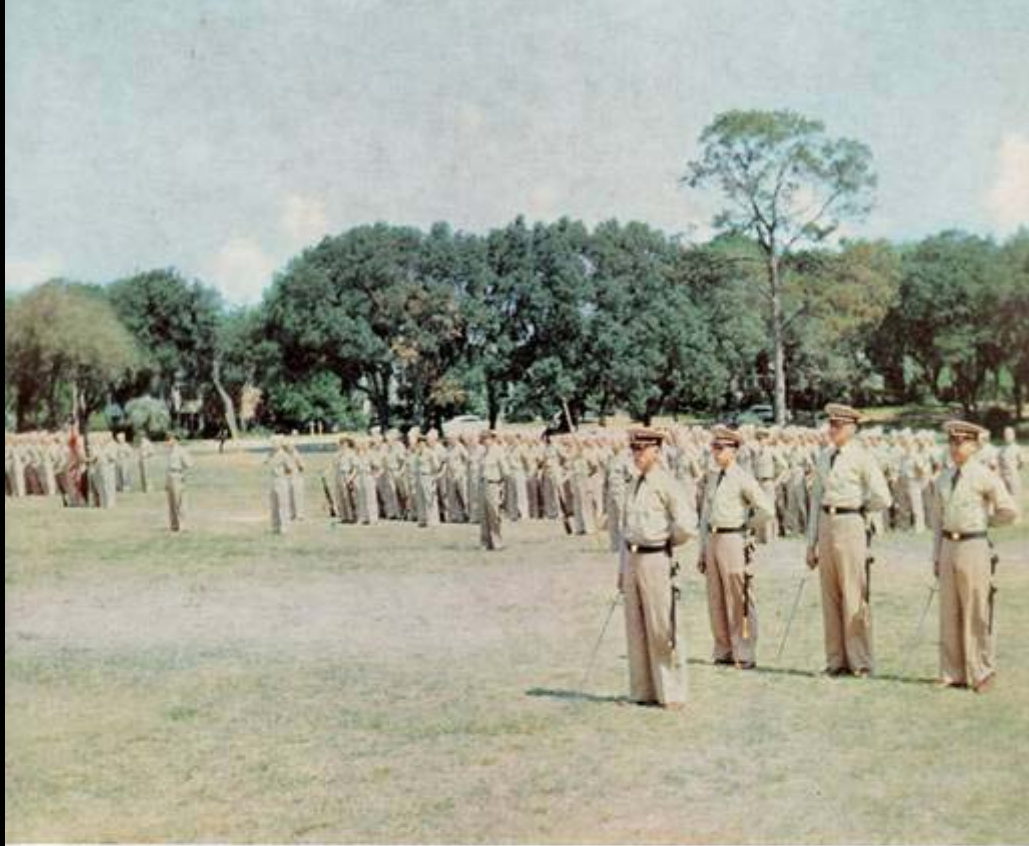
Familiar to all flight students reporting for duty is the impressive main gate at the Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Florida, manned by Navy Sentries 24 hours a day—always alert in keeping the security of the Station.

An old landmark, Building 45 is the headquarters of the Chief of Naval Air Basic Training and his staff.

Building 624 houses the Chief of Naval Air Training who presides over the Navy's largest shore base command. This command includes Basic Training with headquarters in Pensacola; Air Technical Training with headquarters in Memphis; Reserve Training with headquarters in Glenview; Advance Training with headquarters in Corpus Christi.

# SCHOOL

The U. S. Naval School, Pre-Flight is the first step for Aviation Cadets who set out on the path leading to Navy Wings of Gold and a commission in the Navy or the Marine Corps.

In addition the Pre-Flight School provides Naval and Marine Officers—who are undergoing flight training—with an introduction to aeronautical and aeronautically related subjects.

The command is located aboard the 5,500 acre Naval Air Station in Pensacola and is a unit of the Naval Air Basic Training Command. The present school is an outgrowth of the five World War II pre-flight schools which were scattered at universities throughout the country. All these schools were consolidated into one Pre-Flight School at Iowa City, Iowa at the end of the war.

In December 1945, Pre-Flight moved to NAS Ottumwa, Iowa and remained there until July 1947 when it was transferred to its present location at NAS Pensacola.

The mission of Pre-Flight is twofold. First it serves as an officer candidate school for Aviation Cadets in order to equip them for their future

duties as Officers. And it also provides potential flight students with a thorough mental and physical background which they will need when their flight training begins.

In fulfilling this mission, two programs are utilized. Cadets participate in a sixteen week course during which they receive 531.5 hours of training. The curriculum for officer indoctrines—Ois—is made up of 215 hours during eight weeks.

Pre-Flight training is divided into three departments—Academic, Physical Fitness-Survival, and Military. Each department is an essential part of the training program and a passing grade in each is necessary for graduation.

The Academic Department provides formal classroom instruction in aeronautical and Naval subjects. These include Naval Orientation, Aerodynamics, Study Skills, Leadership, Engineering, Aviation Science, and Navigation. In addition to the regular instruction, individual help, mock-ups, and visual aids are utilized to assist the student understand the essential material.

In the Physical Fitness-Survival Department, two aspects of aviation training are stressed—development of muscular coordination and survival at sea. Staffed by trained athletic instructors, this department develops the keen minds and agile bodies that are "musts" for alert and competent aviators. A spirit of sportsmanship and fair play is instilled into the students during their activities that remains with them long after they have completed their training.

The Military Department is concerned with the routine administration, discipline, and military proficiency of each Aviation Cadet. Under the supervision of their Regimental officers, Cadets learn the manual of arms, sword handling, and scores of other techniques that must be acquired before receiving a commission.

When future pilots successfully complete the Pre-Flight program, they are transferred to one of the auxiliary fields in the area for the next phase of naval aviation training. There they put into actual practice everything they were taught at the Pre-Flight School and go forward to fly high with the fleet as a United States Naval Aviator.

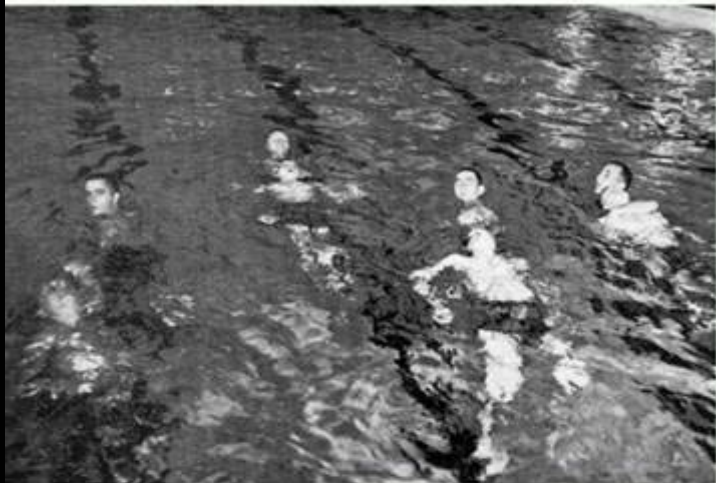

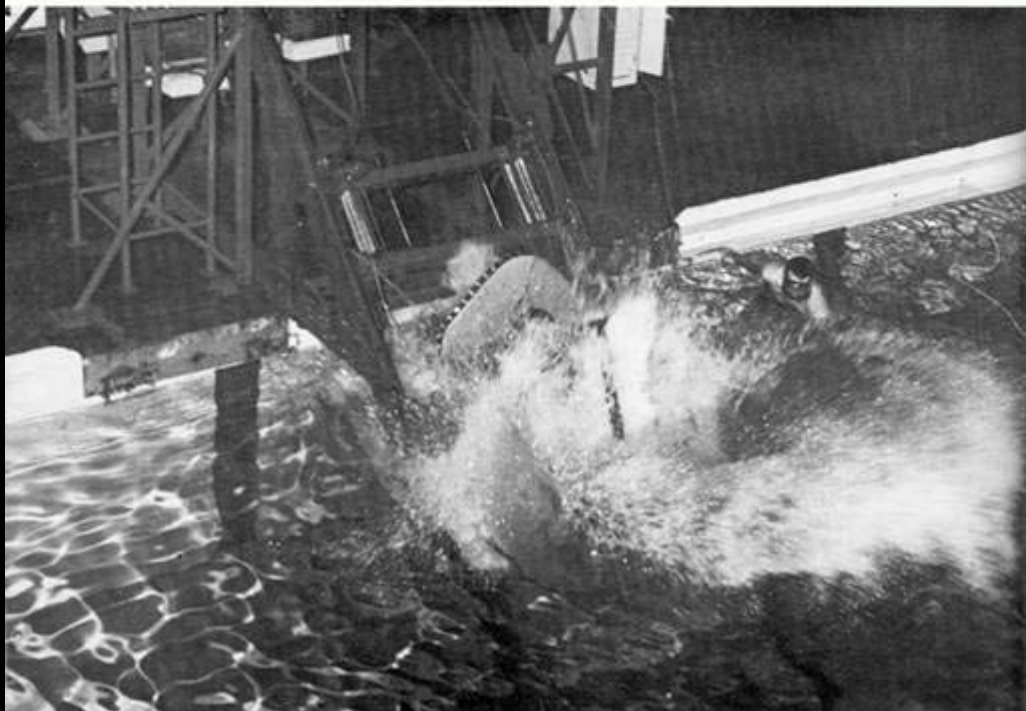

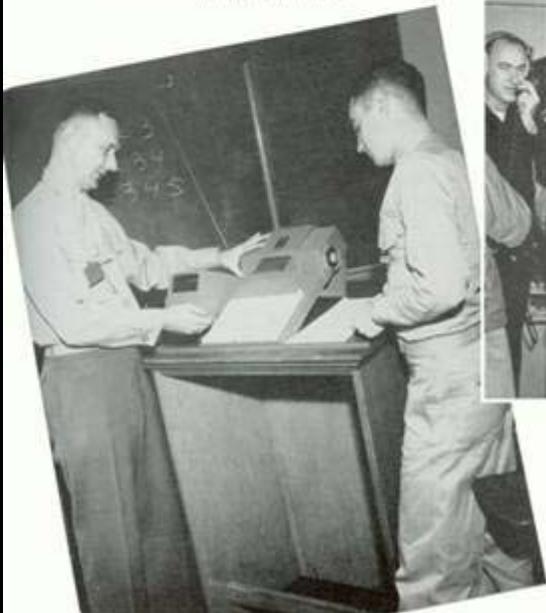

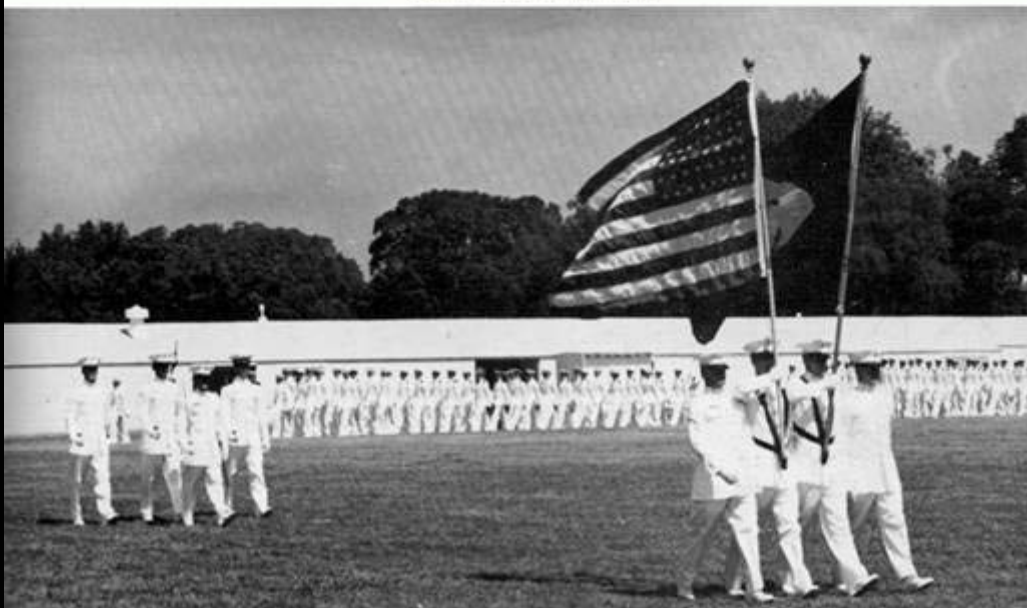

Saufley Field

The first solo flight, for student Naval Aviators, is the first of the many great thrills he will experience in his communion with plane and sky. It happens every day at Saufley Field in Pensacola.

At present Saufley employs the prop driven T-34 in fulfilling its mission of primary flight instruction. The T-34 was introduced to Saufley in the fall of 1956 and already over 11,500 students have completed this phase of their training in the "Mentor."

Saufley Field is about ten miles west of the School of Pre-Flight in Pensacola. Sixteen weeks



of intensive training is required before the student reaches Souley and his first taste of actual flight instruction.

As the student approaches the base along the Souley Field Access Road, he catches a glimpse of the long red and white line of planes that he will learn to know so well. There are over one hundred and forty planes on the "East Line" which is visible from this road.

The first few days at Souley are spent on the routine check-in procedures and the student repeats the process that will become so familiar throughout his flight training . . . he is loaded down with books. There are many, many hours of preparation on the ground for each hour spent in the air. The initial indoctrination, however, includes the introduction to the student's first "squadron." Hanger 809 is the home of Training Squadron One, and is divided into sections for the four

individual flights: Flight 12, 13, 14 and Flight 18, the Marine Corps Flight. Prior to the commissioning of Training Squadron One there were six T-34 squadrons and one TT-1 jet squadron. The primary student is given a brief greeting by his individual flight leader or his assistant and he then checks in to ground training. Here he will actually spend his first week before returning to the hangar.

In ground school the nature of the courses studied changes somewhat from Pre-Flight. The material presented is, for the most part, directly related to the flying that will be done in the weeks ahead. Cockpit procedures, engineering and flight characteristics of the particular aircraft are covered.

After the two weeks of this, the big moment arrives; the student meets his instructor, and weather permitting, they check out on the flight schedules board for the flight line and the PS-1 hop. For

the next six weeks the student's time will be spent equally between ground school and the flight line. Every effort is made to unify the information presented on the ground and in the air in order to make the student's learning experience complete.

Although often not as exciting as the flight phase of training, ground school is an extremely important and vital part of the training. An attempt is made to make aviators who will understand every phase of the missions to which they will be assigned, and to make Naval Officers as well as aviators. The positions of leadership and responsibility to which the student can expect to fall heir are unequalled.

In the hangar the student will find a keen rivalry and a high "esprit de corps." Regular competitions are conducted for student of the week, flight of the month, numerous safety awards, and there are many athletic contests. Squadron parties and Friday afternoon "Happy Hours" add greatly to the feeling of belonging that will prevail throughout the student's Naval Aviation career.

Flight-training at VT-1 is divided into two stages of instruction, pre-solo and precision.

In the pre-solo stage the student receives thirteen flights; eleven dual instructional flights; the PS-12 safe-for-solo check and the PS-13 solo. The dual instructional flights prepare the student for the solo flights he will receive in precision stage by giving him a thorough introduction to landing procedure and technique. He is also taught to cope with various emergencies that may arise and he is taught the local traffic patterns. Good airmanship and safety are stressed at all times.

The PS-12 check flight is flown with an instructor other than the student's regular instructor. Based on long experience of training and checking stu-

dents the check pilot determines whether or not the student is safe to go it alone. To indicate success on this flight the traditional "thumbs up" sign is given by the instructor.

The student's last flight in this stage is his long anticipated first solo flight. Every conceivable emotion has been co-pilot with students on this first solo, but, invariably, a feeling of tremendous pride has accompanied every student as he walked from his plane back to the hangar upon completion of this flight.

Soloing, in spite of its importance to the new pilot, is only the first in a long succession of hurdles to be taken before he is a qualified aviator. After the first solo, training intensifies and the student pilot must learn precision and proficiency flying.

In the precision stage the student refines maneuvers that were introduced in the pre-solo stage and he learns many new ones. A student will generally fly one solo hop and one dual instructional hop while in this stage. The loop, the full cuban eight, the wingover, the barrel roll and the spin become familiar "lingo" in the hangar after the solo acrobatics flights.

The student finishes this phase of his training at VT-1 when he successfully completes his precision stage check. This hop is not only flown with a different instructor, but the instructor comes from another flight.

With the completion of Primary, the student has taken a big step in accomplishing his goal. His confidence in himself and his ability to handle a plane are now real. Although still a long way from his "Wings of Gold" the fledgling has had many experiences and is on his way to establishing habits that will remain with him throughout his life.

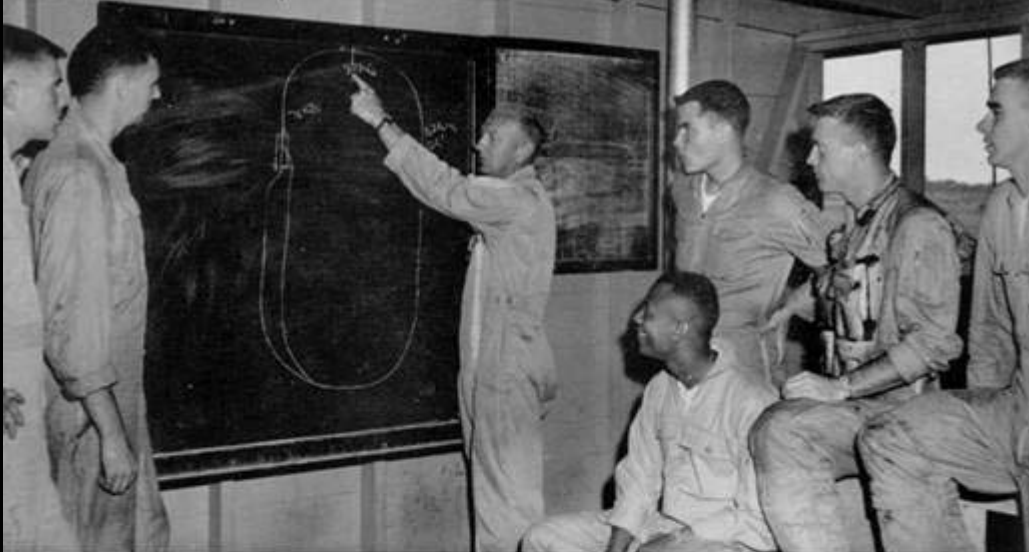

## TRAINING SQUADRON 5

At Saufley Field one will also find Training Squadron Five. This is the carrier qualification unit. When a student completes his training in the T-34 he transfers to Whiting Field for transition to the bigger, faster T-28. When the student is thoroughly competent in the '28 he returns to Saufley for the special training that distinguishes him as a Naval Aviator . . . carrier qualifications.

The student attends two days of ground school. Here he receives flight support and safety lectures, and exams. These consist mainly of carrier safety, performance characteristics of the aircraft as they relate specifically to carrier operations, and the operation of the mirror landing system.

Upon satisfactory completion of ground school and, particularly, the mirror test, the aspiring carrier pilot begins the MFCLP or Mirror Field Carrier Landing Practice phase of instruction. VT-5 is noted for its 0400 reveille. This offers the opportunity for a number of launches for field carrier landing practice before the heat of the day creates annoying turbulence. There are thirteen periods of instruction. The student receives three "demo" flights with an instructor. The remainder of the flights are solo. Approximately eight approaches are flown during each period. At the carrier the student makes two touch and go landings and six arrested landings.

Many students experience a bigger thrill from their

first carrier landings than from their first solo. Perhaps the reason for this is the tremendous anticipation and the suspense. Prior to soloing a student performs every maneuver with his instructor in the back seat that he will perform on his solo. In car-quals, however, seeing the carrier and performing the actual carrier landings is a completely new sensation the first time a student pilot goes aboard. In spite of the anxiety ahead of time, most students seem to agree that their basic carrier landings are easier than the MFCLP's.



# TRAINING

Training Squadrons Two and Three located at NAAAS Whiting Field teach seven of the most important phases of a student aviator's training.

Training Squad Two, located at North Field, provides instruction in transition, precision and acrobatics, and VT-3 at South Field teaches basic instruments, night flying, formation and gunnery.

Learning to fly the North American T-28 or BTG-2 is called the transition stage. This is a big step as the T-28 is a much heavier aircraft, has a larger and more powerful engine, and climbs and cruises much faster than the smaller Beechcraft T-34 which the student flew in primary at Soufley.

As one instructor remarked, "it's like driving a Cadillac after having driven a Volkswagon."

Transition is normally completed in nine 1.3 hour hops. The first eight are dual flights and the student is instructed in climbing and let down procedures, simulated high altitude emergency, pre-flight inspections, outlying field entry and full flap landings. He solos the T-28 on the ninth flight.

Precision is next. In this stage the student learns how to make precision landings at one of Whiting's outlying fields. A box is drawn on the runway and the pilot is supposed to land in the boxed area. Basic air work is smoothed out and wing-overs are practiced. An average of 9.1 flight hours are flown in this phase.

He is now ready to go into the acrobatic phase of training. This 10-hop syllabus consists of four duals and six solos. There are four standard maneuvers performed in acrobatics—loops, barrel rolls, the immelmann and the half-Cuban eight. Performance of acrobatics is basically the same for all aircraft, the fundamental difference being power settings and air speed.

All the while he is flying in transition, precision and acrobatics (or TPA as it is commonly called) the student is also attending Ground School. He usually flies half a day and goes to school the rest of the day.

The TPA takes approximately six to eight weeks, depending on the weather and other factors, but he is well prepared for basic instruments, night flying, formation and gunnery.

In the instrument syllabus the main factor stressed is attitude instrument flight. Attitude is the position of a plane's nose and wings in reference to the earth. He spends most of his time under the hood and is taught to develop a scan pattern. The student learns to rely on his instruments.

Learning to fly in formation takes 11 flights—the first four are dual. Relative motion is stressed in formation flying, and the lead plane is the ref-

erence when flying parade or rendezvous. There are two-plane and four-plane solo flights with a chase pilot.

Before leaving Whiting the student must be well versed in both day and night navigation. In day navigation he is taught how to plan a route and use navigational charts, how to organize various check points on his route and how to distinguish highways, railroads, lakes, etc. He solos with a chase pilot and can go anywhere in the area. Occasionally a student will fly to Memphis or Jacksonville and remain overnight.

Night flying consists of two cross country hops. Dead reckoning techniques are used and an average flight would see a student pilot flying from Whiting to Crestview to Dothan and Andalusia and back to Whiting via Crestview. Each flight lasts for about 1.5 hours and students receive one lecture and one night briefing and observation flight before they actually fly.

The last phase of training the student undergoes here is gunnery. The gunnery syllabus is composed of five flights, the first being a dual demonstration hop and the other four solos. The first four are simulated dry runs and the fifth is a firing flight. All are flown over the Gulf of Mexico.

When all this training has been completed—approximately 20 weeks in the T-28 trainer, 12-14 weeks of ground school—the student is ready to return to Soufley Field for Carrier Qualification training.

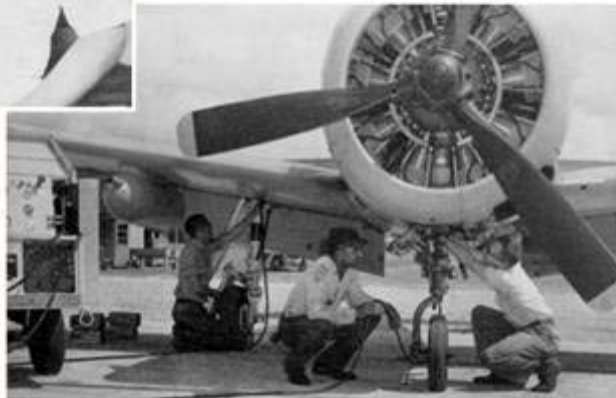

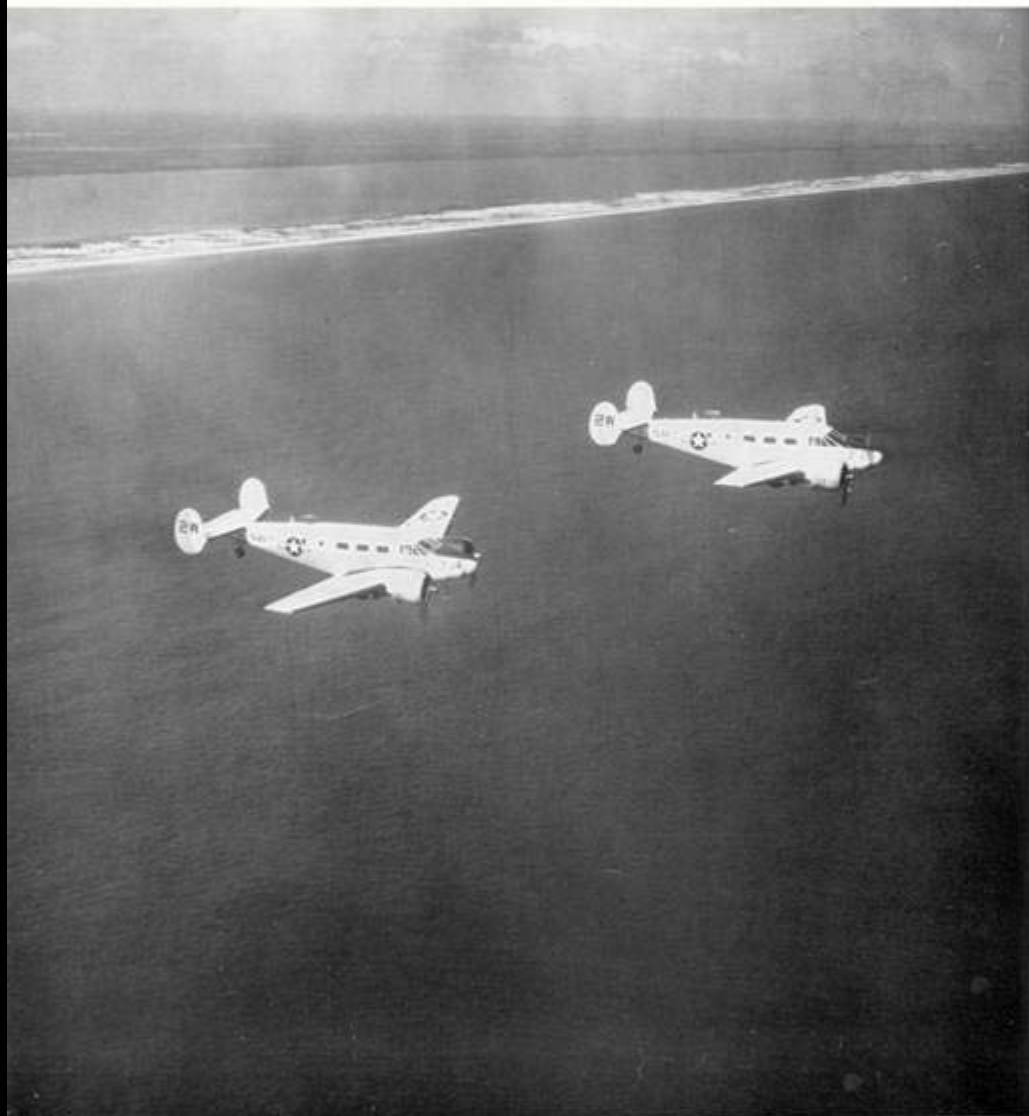




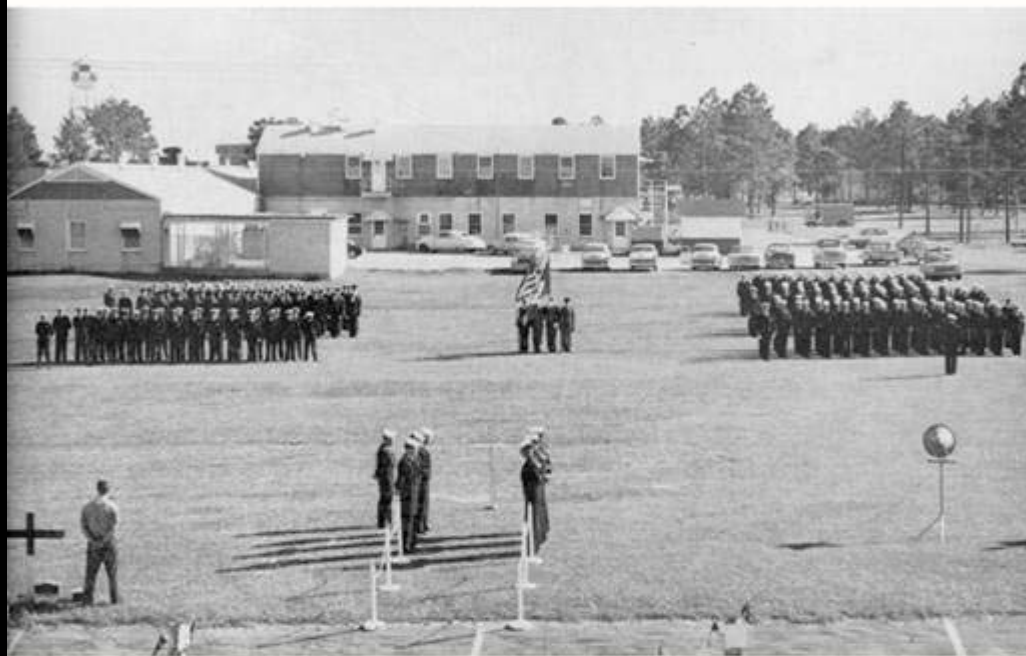

# SQUADRON 6

Training Squadron SIX, one of three commissioned squadrons operating from NAAS Whiting Field, is under the command of CDR. G. D. WALKER, USN and is physically located at North Field. Administrative officers are in Building 1472 and the training department conducts flight operations from North Field hanger 1424.

The mission of TRARON SIX is to train student naval aviators designated for helicopter specialization to meet the high degree of instrument proficiency required to obtain a Standard Instrument rating.

The student, while attached to VT-6, will undergo four phases of training. They are transition, basic instruments, radio instruments and cross country. The transition stage consists of eight flights to familiarize the student with the SNB. If certain standards of safety and proficiency are met the student's next flight is a solo with his flying partner

as co-pilot. During the basic instrument stage the student must strive for a solid foundation in flight through instrument interpretation upon which all his further instrument flight training will be based. When the student can pilot his aircraft satisfactorily through precision maneuvers without visual reference outside the cockpit he is ready for radio instrument instruction.

In the radio instrument phase the student is taught the most complex and demanding aspect of piloting an aircraft. He learns all the procedures and techniques necessary to qualify him in the use of radio navigational aids. These aids and a thorough knowledge of how to use them will guide his aircraft safely under any weather conditions.

Cross country is the final stage and finishing school of the student's fixed wing training. In these flights he is taught under actual conditions the practical application of all that he has learned.

Now he is the pilot, the flight planner, and will use his training experiences to guide his decisions on route, weather and destination.

At the completion of his training at TRARON SIX the student is a highly qualified individual capable of piloting his aircraft from one base to another without visual reference to the ground from take-off to within a few hundred feet of the runway at his destination.

TRARON SIX has an average of 32 flight instructors and is assigned 24 SNB type aircraft to ac-

completing this training. The flight instructors in TRARON SIX average between 50 and 60 hours of flight time each month. The squadron receives approximately 16 flight students every two weeks, with "Welcome Aboard" lectures given the new students at 1300 on the Friday afternoon of their arrival. While on board TRARON SIX they will receive 84 hours of flying and 25 hours of ground instruction. When a student leaves TRARON SIX he is a thoroughly qualified instrument pilot ready to begin his specialized training in helicopters.

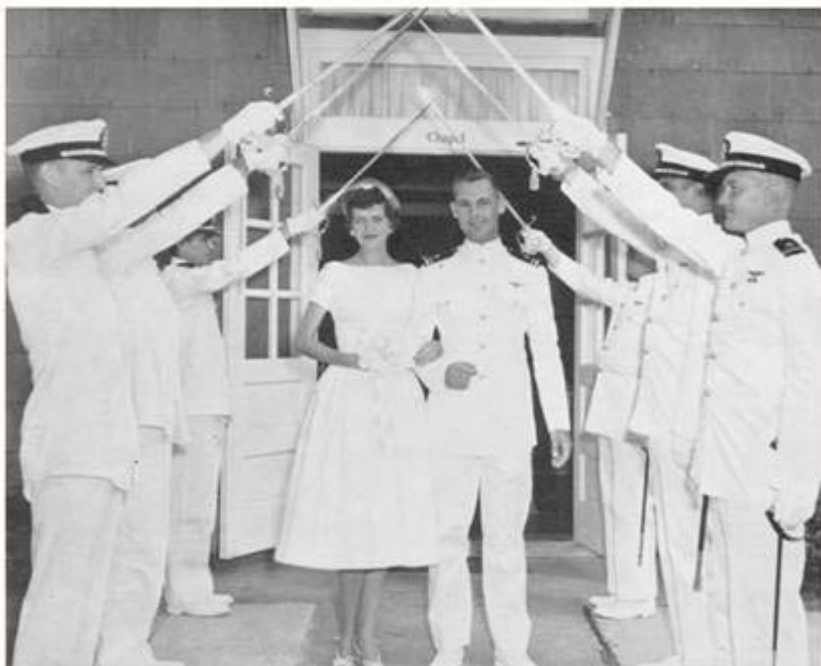

# TRAINING

NAAS

At Training Squadron SEVEN the student commences a most significant portion of his development into a Naval Aviator. Here he will receive one hundred and eighty-six hours of Academic Instruction in such subjects as aircraft engineering, aerodynamics, meteorology, navigation, leadership and special weapons orientation. In addition to the ground instruction phase, he accumulates approximately 110 hours of flight instruction, mastering the techniques of primary flight, basic and radio instrument navigation, formation, gunnery, and carrier qualification. The North American T2J-1 "Buckeye," a two place jet trainer, is the aircraft utilized by the Squadron to accomplish its flying mission.

# U. S. NAVAL AIR STATION

U. S. NAVAL AIR STATION PENSACOLA, FLORIDA

The Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Florida the "Annapolis of the Air" is the home of the Naval Air Training Command. It was naval aviation's first home and nearly all of the aviators in our Navy have been trained or served as instructors here at one time. Founded as a navy yard back

in 1826, nineteen years before Florida became a state, it was unanimously chosen to be the first naval air station in 1914. The wisdom of this choice has been proven throughout the years and NAS Pensacola remains one of the finest and largest air stations in the world.

The Naval Air Station's primary function is to furnish logistic support to the Naval Air Basic Training Command in the coordination and direction of all basic flight training, ground training and specialized training in the aviation field. In addition, it is the home of two of its own squadrons, BTG-9, Basic Jet Training Group NINE; and METG (Multi-Engine Training Group), plus being the residence of the Navy's spectacular flight demonstration team, the "Blue Angels."

Each year 3,000 young men come to NAS Pensacola in quest of the coveted "Navy Wings of Gold." These future aviators embark on a career which boasts a proud tradition. # TRAINING

Along with Training Squadron Seven in Kingsville, Training Squadron Four, located at Forrest Sherman Field, has the job of training flight students in all phases of basic jet training after the students have finished primary flight training.

Using North American Aviation's T2J "Buckeye," student aviators fly over 100 hours in the Navy's latest and only basic jet training plane.

Included in his instruction are: transition, precision, acrobatics, radio instrument, navigation, formation flying, gunnery and night flying.

Climax of their flight schedule is jet carrier qualifying aboard the USS ANTIETAM, training carrier operating in the Gulf of Mexico.

In addition to the flight phase of training, each student receives about 200 hours of academic instruction and about 50 hours of flight support lectures.

VT-4 was renamed for Basic Training Group Seven which was the first jet training unit in the history of the Naval Air Basic Training Command.

## U. S. S. ANTIETAM...CVS-36

The day a student pilot makes his six qualifying landings aboard the USS ANTIETAM is the goal of weeks of classes, training, theory and Field Carrier Landing Practice.

It is now that he feels the close kindred spirit that exists between the pilots and the men who man the fleet carriers. The landings and takeoffs run like clockwork as the LSO, Flight Deck Officer, and all the men who wear the bright colored jerseys work together as a team.

The USS ANTIETAM reported to the Chief of Naval Air Basic Training in April 1957 as the new training carrier after spending the last three years operating with the Antisubmarine Force of the Atlantic Fleet. When the USS ANTIETAM entered the Brooklyn Naval Shipyard in 1952 for her regular overhaul period she was a straight deck "Essex" class carrier. When she left the yard in January 1953 she was the first angled deck aircraft carrier in the world. The ANTIETAM proved to everyone that the angled deck carrier has three great advantages over the normal fore-and-aft deck carrier. First, it increases the efficiency of the ship by allowing simultaneous takeoffs and landings. Secondly, it increases the safety of flight operations by always providing a clear deck ahead for landing aircraft. Lastly, it increases the effectiveness of the ship by allowing her to land aircraft of larger dimensions on board without fear of striking the island structure. Carrier training on board the USS ANTIETAM will greatly reduce the transition training of pilots reporting to the fleet on completion of flight training, since practically all operational carriers now have the angled flight deck.

## N. A. A. S. MERIDIAN

The U.S. Naval Auxiliary Air Station, Meridian, Mississippi, is part of the NAVAL AIR BASIC TRAINING COMMAND and is located 16 miles northeast of Meridian, Miss. It is the Navy's newest and most modern stateside installation.

The base was commissioned in a development status on December 31, 1959. A formal commissioning ceremony was held on 14 July 1961 at which time the Operational area (Centroid) was named McCain Field in honor of the late ADMIRAL John Sidney McCAIN, USN.

NAAS MERIDIAN was carved out of rolling, timber-laden and marshland terrain. Actual construction work has been in progress for the past three and one half years.

To build the three runways, workmen gouged out hills, diverted streams, and filled in swamps. In one instance, an 80 foot hill was leveled and the earth used for fill, running up to 40 feet in a few of the lower sections.

The Navy's multi-million dollar jet training base, spread out over an 8,000 acre tract, commenced full operations in July, 1961. It is one of two stations in the United States where Navy Fliers receive basic jet training in the North American T2J-1 "Buckeye."

Approximately 500 student aviators will be trained yearly with about 200 on board at one time. Classes will be composed of Cadets, commissioned officers from the Naval Academy, NROTC, OCS, General Line, the Marine Corps, and a number of foreign students.

Students will come to Meridian after Pre-flight training at the U.S. Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Florida, and preliminary training at Soufley Field. They will be exposed to jets for the first time at Meridian and will accumulate about 100 hours flying time before moving on to training in more advanced types of aircraft at Corpus Christi, Texas.

# HELICOPTER TRAINING

ELLYSON FIELD

On December 3, 1950 the Navy's only helicopter training school was commissioned at Elyson Field, an auxiliary landing field located nine miles north of Pensacola. Helicopter Training Squadron EIGHT trains all the rotary wing pilots for the Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard.

The course of instruction consists of 9-12 intensive weeks of ground and flight instruction. It is available to seasoned aviators who wish to become proficient in this type of flying as well as to aviators who have just completed basic training.

The versatility of the helicopter in performing near impossible tasks has greatly increased their usage throughout the naval service. Their effectiveness during the Korean Conflict proved their value in combat. Their diligent efforts during hurricane and flood reliefs have proven their value in humanitarian causes, and certainly their vigilance as Air Sea Rescue Units have proven their worth. Add to these tremendous tasks, the task of the helicopter in antisubmarine warfare, where its ability to detect, track, and attack a submerged object is exploited, and some of the general usages of the helicopter can be visualized.

To meet the ever increasing need for professional precision helicopter pilots, to support these tasks, the training program at HT-8 is so gauged to live up to its trade mark that, "The Best Helicopter Pilots in the World are Trained Here." Whether the student is an aviation cadet, a junior officer or an officer of flag rank, when he finishes the helicopter training program, he can take his place with the best.

# NAVAL AVIATION



N.A.S. Pensacola became the site of the Navy's latest innovation in aviation officer training school, on 1 July 1960, when the Naval Aviation Officers School accepted its first class of 22 officers. Eventually over 800 qualified air crewmen and aviation ground officers will join the fleet each year.

With the inception of the Basic NAO school, many officers, highly motivated towards duties in navigation, radar, electronics, special weapons and other applied fields, are now given an ample opportunity to build substantial Naval careers.

During the eight week school the officer-students will follow a curriculum designed to better acquaint them with the Naval Aviation billets in the fleet. Their course of study will include aviation electronics, Combat Information Centers, air intelligence, communications, Naval Leadership, jet engines, meteorology, navigation, special weapons and Naval Aviation indoctrination.

During the flight phase the students will receive familiarization flights in various types of aircraft. The air crew trainees will fly 20 hours and the ground officer trainees will complete 6½ hours aloft. The school utilizes the T-34, T-28, SNB, S2F and T2V to promulgate its flight schedule.

The type of specialist training which the student will receive following their graduation from the NAO school is determined by the needs of the service, the individual's background, abilities and personal desires. Prior to the completion of each class, a board of instructors will make appropriate recommendations to CNABATRA and CNATRA concerning further student training.
